Theora Quik Alert is an affordable, easy-to-use accessory that keeps caregivers informed of a care recipient's presence inside. Theora Quik Alert at Home consists of a small-sized, state-of-the-art sensor that installs in seconds on an internal wall, and initiates a text to the caregiver's smartphone immediately when your care recipient leaves the premises. Simple to use, just place the sensor on an internal wall and download the free caregiver smartphone app.

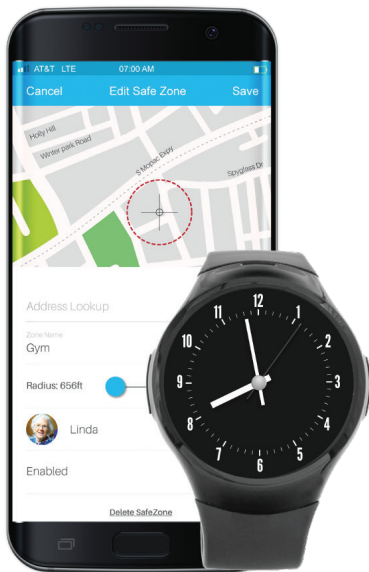
